

Summer Camp Offering Overview

It is our belief that music empowers people and changes lives. Ethos Sound Music School provides campers with the opportunity to collaborate with others and find their artistic voice while promoting self-esteem, creativity, effective communication, respect for others, social skills and emotional expression.

This summer, we are offering 3 different camps. Each camp is a 1-week intensive couture experience designed to provide social interaction opportunities between young musicians and professional musicians. All camps will run 11:00AM-3:00PM, Monday through Friday. Students participating should want to learn more about playing an instrument and/or singing. On the first Monday of each week's session, We introduce the staff/counselors talking about what they do and then have the campers introduce themselves to the group. Each camp will follow a different curriculum to make for a fresh music experience week to week. Repeat campers are encouraged and welcomed.

Content: Topics explored during our camps include, but are not limited to:

- Instrument and ensemble coaching
- Social Activities Geared Towards Age + Level
- Song selection and arranging
- Professionalism and stage presence

Audition: A 30 second video audition will be requested to better determine the students' musical level. The auditions will ensure a curated curriculum for the students attending the camp. 5 day camp (Session A: June, Session B: July)

5-day camp runs 11AM to 3PM Monday through Thursday and 11:00AM to 2:00PM on Friday at which point we break until 3PM when everyone comes back for sound check at 4:00PM. End of the week Friday night Concerts will begin at 5:00PM. The length of the concert will be TBD but we expect it would last until 7:00PM. Subject to change based on attendance.

All Friday concerts will commence at 5:00PM. We highly recommend the camper to sign up to perform. We will have instructors perform in between camper performances. We strongly believe performance is an important part of the experience, but will not be mandatory. We understand the final performance can seem like a scary experience but is extremely rewarding for building confidence and self esteem.

Cost & Commitment:

- 5 day camp is \$799.00 per week (20+ Hours Of Instruction)
- By The Hour (Full camp experience cannot be guaranteed. This is a great option for ages 4-10). A young camper will be assigned a separate camp counselor that will create a custom learning experience in the camp environment. The counselor will guide the young camper in learning songs in a private one on one setting. Cost for the hour is \$59.99.

Bands typically consist of drums, bass, vocalist, two guitars, and keyboards.

Registration Policy: All Summer Camps - Registration fees must be paid in full by 2 weeks (14 days) before the camp commences or at time of registration. We will contact the parent guardian listed, if we haven't received payment in advance. Payment is necessary to reserve your spot. *In the case that we reach out to make a payment request and receive no response, we reserve the right to offer your spot to someone else.*

No Cell Phone Zone

Camp is all about the music and not being plugged into something else. All cell phones must be muted and not used during classes.

Cancellation/Refund Policy: All cancellation requests must be made in writing prior to (email is fine). The school will retain a 50% cancellation fee and will refund the balance. If your child gets sick within a week of the start date of camp and has a doctor's note, Ethos Sound Music School will keep the 50% cancellation fee but will refund the balance. Day of the camp, all registration and fees are non-refundable. If a camper leaves or is dismissed from camp during the session because of any reason other than health (doctor's note required), No Refund Will Be Made.
